# Family finds room to grow at Alder Commons

Eliseo and Mirian lived in a small Hillsboro apartment with their four small children, and while they were able to make it work for several years, the situation was inadequate for a family of six. To make matters worse, their rent increased every year, becoming unaffordable.

Mirian takes care of the kids while Eliseo works as a landscaper during the day. On certain evenings after work, he sings at church to take a moment for himself to do what he loves. But as hard as they worked, buying a home was still out of reach, until they connected with Habitat.

In January, the family moved into their own home at Habitat’s new Alder Commons in Hillsboro. Eliseo said it is comforting knowing that the home is affordable and will be a lasting investment for his family.

“It’s a nice place for everybody and there is nothing more special than a house,” Eliseo said. “The house is a blessing for our kids. They know it’s their home now.”

Mirian is a second-generation Habitat homeowner. Her mother moved into her own Habitat home in Beaverton 15 years ago, where she is close enough to help watch the kids. For Eliseo, having helped build his and his neighbors’ homes and seeing the community come to life was a special experience.

“It’s everything,” he said. “It’s win, win, win.”

# The path to homeownership

Each year, we are excited to work with new individuals and families on their journey to homeownership. That journey begins while the homes are still under construction when applicants submit their interest to our Homeownership team.

Habitat homebuyers have an average household income of about \$51,000. Each homebuyer attends homeownership education classes to prepare them to be successful homeowners in the future.

Habitat connects homebuyers with preferred lenders to provide affordable mortgages that let them build equity while keeping the home affordable for future owners. By partnering with Proud Ground, the Portland region’s largest community land trust, we can ensure these homes stay affordable for generations.

Even after homeowners move in, Habitat continues to support success by providing homeownership education classes for homeowners to learn about maintaining their home, securing financial wellbeing, and becoming more engaged in their communities.

# Helping people stay in their homes as they age

**Habitat partners with homeowners with low incomes to complete repairs that alleviate health and safety issues.**

Our goal is to prevent displacement and support aging in place by making repairs such as replacing roofs, siding and gutters; addressing minor plumbing issues; installing wheelchair ramps; and providing other accessibility improvements, such as adding grab bars and removing trip hazards.

In 2024, we provided 36 repairs to 85 people across the Portland metropolitan region and have plans to complete 60 repairs in the coming year.

# Repair ensures future of family home

**When Anna partnered with Habitat’s Home Repair program, it was to install a wheelchair ramp at their home for her mother Evelyn.** But shortly after her mother passed away last year, the ramp became a lifeline for Anna herself.

Anna suffered a fall that broke her pelvis and five ribs. She could hardly walk, and the ramp provided therapy and mobility, and the security of staying in her own home – the home she’s lived in for 65 years.

“We didn’t have a lot growing up, and so to be able to stay here for a little longer would mean so much to me,” Anna said. “But I wouldn’t be able to stay here if I didn’t have things in place, like the ramp, to be able to do that.”

# Building a new future today

**This year, we celebrated a record 50 home sales in the Portland region.**

Two new neighborhoods came to life as homeowners moved into our Alder Commons and Foster Commons communities in Hillsboro and southeast Portland. And we've set in place the foundation and framework for even more homes across the region.

Century Commons, our new 18-home community in Hillsboro, developed quickly this past year with 3- and 4-bedroom townhomes now walled in, along with 4 single-level, ADA-ready homes. Right on Century's heels is our new 16-home King City Commons, which saw framework rising from new foundations last spring.

At each of these sites and others, teams of volunteers and homebuyers work alongside staff, fostering direct relationships and a sense of community in the shared mission to ensure everyone has a safe and affordable place to call home.

For all the excitement happening on construction sites, Habitat staff never stop working to secure land and funding to put new communities in motion. In addition to the **50 homes sold** this past year, Habitat has **165 homes in different phases of construction** across the Portland region.



# The milestones ahead

**Looking to the coming year, we're excited to embark on multiple landmark communities across the Portland region.**

This year, we celebrated the launch of West Lake Grove, a 23-home community in the Lake Grove neighborhood of Lake Oswego, bringing a welcomed addition to a city lacking affordable homeownership opportunities.

"Children will grow up here, families will live here who would never otherwise be able to afford a home in Lake Oswego," said Lake Oswego Mayor Joe Buck. "The diversity of the population required to have a healthy, robust and vibrant community demands that more of us come together and continue to say, 'Yes, this is just the beginning for Lake Oswego.'"

We're also excited to begin work on Gooseberry Trails, our largest community to date, bringing 52 new, affordable homes to the Hillsdale neighborhood in southwest Portland. In Gresham, preparation is underway for 20 new homes in the Rockwood neighborhood. Myrtlewood Way promises to become a vibrant community in a culturally rich area of the Portland region. With 165 homes in different phases of construction, this coming year will be one of our busiest ever!

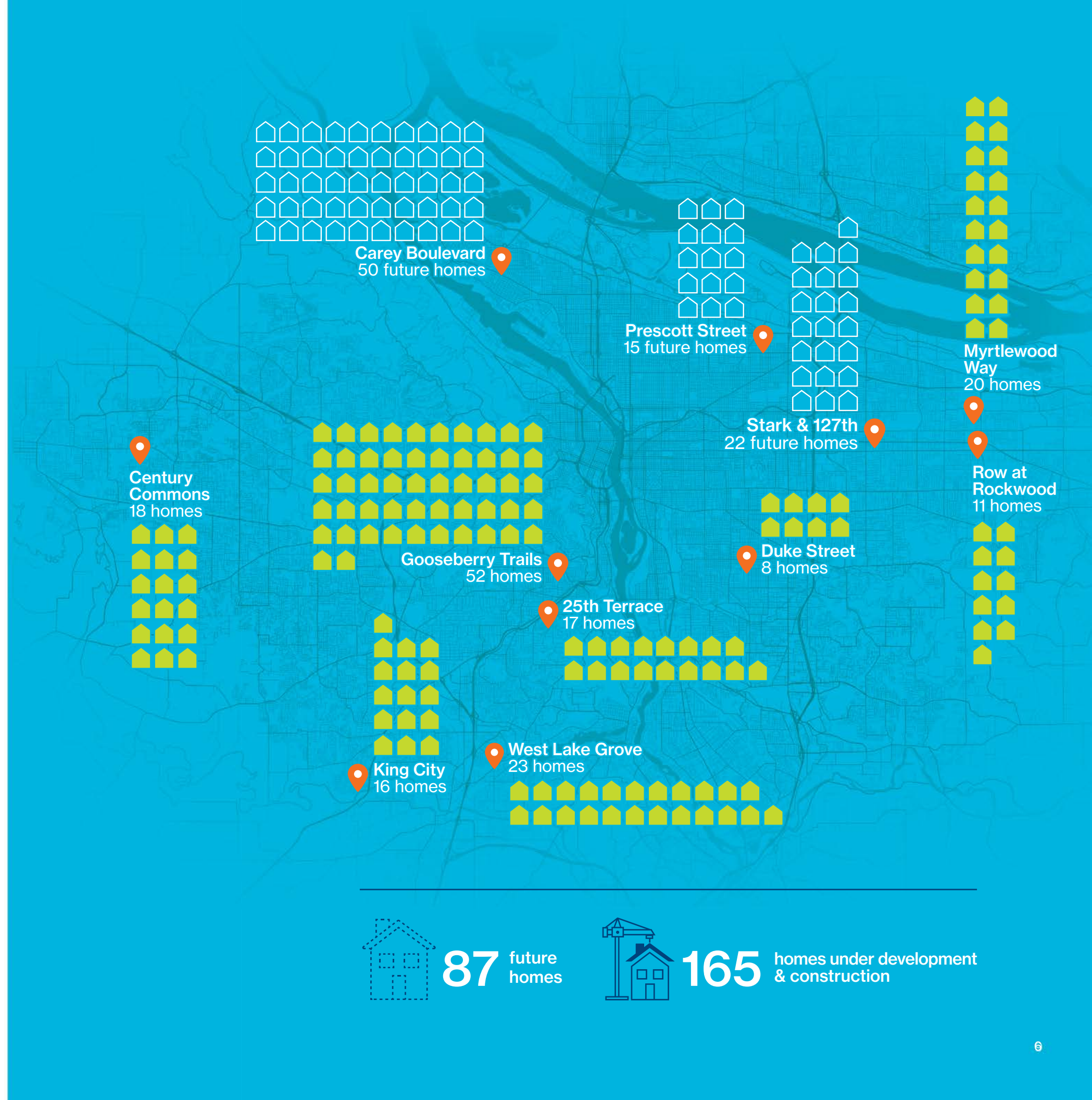


2024 PROGRESS MAP

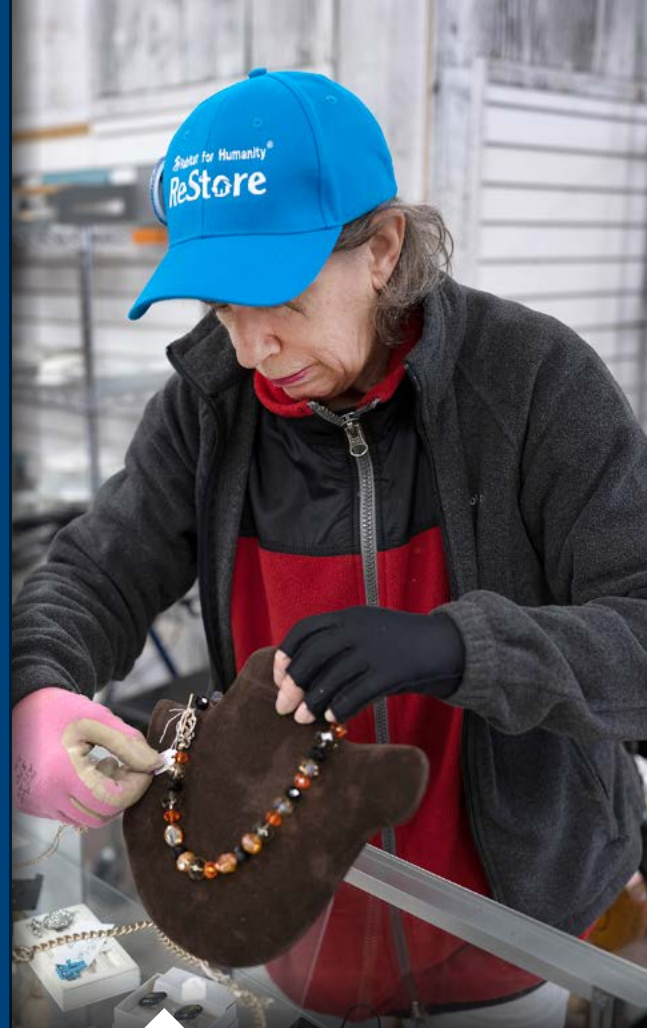
# The store that builds and repairs homes

# Habitat's advocacy priorities

**Habitat for Humanity Portland Region advocates at the local, state, and federal levels to protect and expand policies and resources for affordable homeownership and thriving communities.**

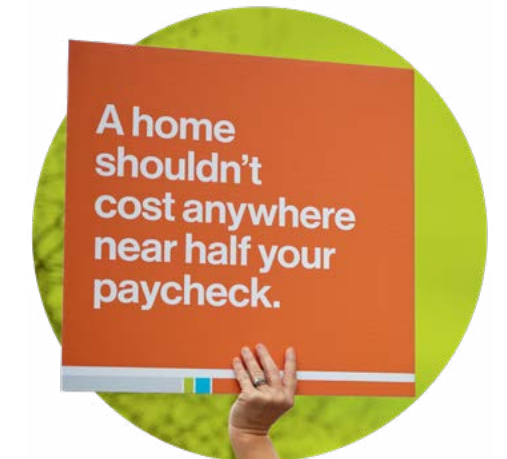
Our advocacy priorities are to build more affordable homes for sale, provide equitable access to homeownership, plan for inclusive land use, and provide more housing opportunities for historically marginalized communities.

The 2024 Oregon legislative session achieved historic housing investments but also pointed to the sustained effort needed to ensure that affordable homeownership is included in the state's funding and policy priorities. Amid a housing crisis, investments across the housing continuum are needed. By investing in homeownership, we free up affordable rentals and create a path to lasting stability, not just a temporary roof. That's why we're partnering with Habitat Oregon to support the Unlocking Homeownership campaign, which will bring ambitious homeownership goals to the 2025 session.

At the federal level, our annual Habitat on the Hill convenes more than 400 advocates from across the country to share policy strategies and to meet with senators and representatives to advocate for housing and homeownership. In 2024, Habitat Portland Region was proud to showcase Portland's innovative anti-displacement strategy, the North/Northeast Preference Policy. In recognition of past actions that have marginalized and displaced longtime residents of North and Northeast Portland, the Portland Housing Bureau developed a preference policy that allowed households with generational ties to remain in or return to the area. The initiative helps address the city's legacy of displacement and marginalization of largely African American neighborhoods due to urban renewal, redlining, and racist lending policies.

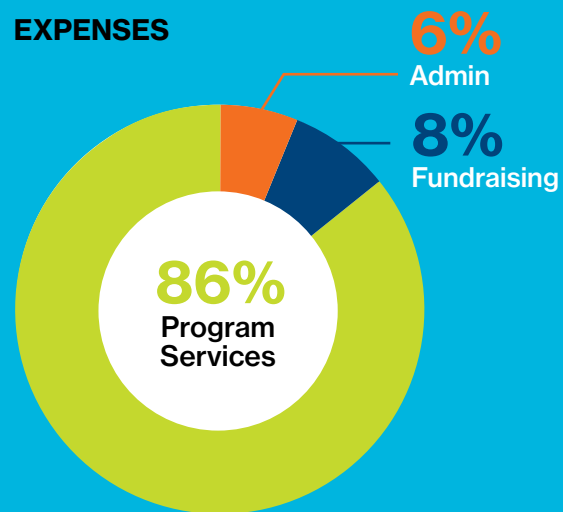
