PROJECT NAME: West Lake Grove

PROJECT LOCATION: 16858 Boones Ferry Road, Lake Oswego, Oregon 97035

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Residential Community- 23 Townhouse style units across 6 buildings

SCOPE OF WORK: Fence Installation

DATE OF WORK: Start December 2025

BID DUE DATE: November 15th 2025

Scope of Work:

Schedule

- 1. Anticipated Start: Dec 2025 Building 1: 4' Cedar Fences
- 2. Habitat superintendent to communicate exact dates.
- 3. Send Habitat submittal information within 5 days of contract execution.

Durations:

- 1. 4' Cedar Fence (Private Yard)
- 2. 6' Cedar Fence (Property Line)
- 3. Gate: Integrated gate frame and hinges, or shop-fabbed gate frame

Mobilizations:

1. Up to 3 TBD During Pre-Contract Meeting

Scope

Phase 1: 6' Cedar Fence (Property Line) #2 tight knot cedar fence boards and KD #2 doug fir rails

- 1. Site prep, clearing, layout and grading as needed in accordance to tree protection plans. Site visit to confirm.
- 2. Provide all labor and materials to install 6' privacy fence, along perimeter property line, per construction plans. Special attention to tree protection areas where hand digging is required.
- 3. Use stainless fasteners (Do not use galvanized as spec on plan).
- 4. Remove and haul off dirt spoils from fence post holes.
- 5. Wet set fence posts in concrete with Rot Bloc flashings to protect post from concrete.

Phase 2: Private Yard Fence (4') #2 tight knot cedar fence boards and KD #2 doug fir rails

- 1. Provide all labor and materials to install yard fences and gates, per construction plans
- 2. Use stainless fasteners (Do not use galvanized as spec on plan).
- 3. Remove and haul off dirt spoils from fence post holes.
- 4. Wet set fence posts in concrete with Rot Bloc flashings to protect post from concrete.

NOTE: Habitat is a nonprofit organization that seeks to engage volunteers on its projects, there may be a need for Habitat to remove some of the fencing from the contractor's scope of work in order to self-perform with volunteers.
