

# Join the Pope Leo Village

The Pope Leo Village is a multi-city campaign launched by an anonymous donor who was inspired by Pope Leo XIV's teachings on justice, compassion, and service. It invites people of all faiths, identities, and generations to come together in support of affordable housing.

Locally, The Pope Leo Village will support **Habitat for Humanity Portland Region's Twenty Fifth Terrace** community — 17 affordable homes being built in SW Portland. Every dollar raised and every hour volunteered helps families and individuals achieve strength and stability through homeownership.

The Pope Leo Village campaign launches January 2026 and runs through the completion of the Twenty Fifth Terrace construction, approximately February 2027.
