CREW brings women together to create real, lasting change. Members play an active role in supporting women-led homeownership and empowering women across the Portland region through hands-on volunteering.

Supporting women to become homeowners.

CREW helps women and women-led households access stable, affordable homeownership through fundraising and advocacy. The housing crisis directly affects women in Portland. The average household can only afford to buy a home in three neighborhoods in Portland. For single mothers, that number drops to zero.¹

Empowering women through hands-on volunteering.

CREW creates pathways for women to gain confidence, construction skills, and leadership experience by volunteering on Habitat build sites, including the Women+ Community Build Day.

Frame a Future (late September/early October)

CREW members promote our event that raises funds to frame homes and futures.

Host and promote the Women+ Community Build Day.

Attend at least one CREW Service Day at one of the
Habitat ReStores.

Donate:

Commit to donating or fundraising towards
the group goal of \$100,000*.

Spread awareness of Habitat and its mission:

Introduce people to Habitat through fundraising,
volunteering, and/or events.
